(2) Athletes must wear a mawashi on top of a leotard.

Competition event	(1) Individual competitions will be divided by weight.*The competition method will be decided by the tournament preparation committee, and each class will compete for the championship. ·There will be 6 weight classes as follows:However, entries will be limited to one category per person. (2) Team competitions will be open to three players. ·The manager may also serve as the player. - Player changes can only be made to registered players in team competitions.

medical affairs	(1) If a participating athlete sustains an injury during the match, the organizer will provide first aid, but will not be responsible for the aftermath. (Participating athletes must enroll accident insurance from their schools or individually) (2) The doping test will be as follows. ·At the time of entry, participants in this competition agreed to undergo a doping test in accordance with the Japan Doping Prevention Regula Consider that minors are deemed to have obtained consent from their parents for the testing. ·Participants of this competition may refuse the doping test or fail to follow the inspector's instructions due to personal circumstances. If you fail to complete the doping inspection procedure, it will be a violation of the doping prevention regulations.
